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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Terms

- 1. Requests to be received two (2) weeks prior to the visit / via an invite from the Eskom Media Desk
- 2. Permission is granted by the Power Station General Manager (accountable owner of the National Key Point) and subject to the acceptance of the conditions set out below
- 3. A signed copy of this two page document must please be returned to Eskom no less than four days before the visit in order for the internal team to arrange access, prepare for personal protective equipment etc.

Conditions

- 1. Members of the crew may not, under any circumstances, touch or interfere with the power station plant or business operations.
- All security related installations may not be captured in any footage whatsoever
- 3. Members of the crew must remain in authorised areas only, and at all times be accompanied by a delegated Eskom employee.
- 4. All vehicle movement is restricted to the road(s) and within the site speed limit. Vehicles will be permitted to leave the road surface only if permission is specifically granted.
- 5. Animals and plants are in no way to be disturbed, trampled, harmed or removed.
- 6. Do not enter the site with any drugs, alcohol, or any weapons.
- 7. Proper receptacles to be provided for waste material. All refuse generated during the course of the filming to be removed.
- 8. No fires, of any description, under any circumstances, to be lit.
- Spot checks may be carried out by Eskom personnel and this permit should be produced on demand.
- 10. The producer/person in charge of the on-site filming activities will be held responsible for all actions of people working with or under him/her while on site.
- 11. Entry into the Power Station is entirely at own risk and Eskom Holdings Ltd can in no way be held responsible for any damage/loss/injury/death to journalists or filming personnel or their property
- 12. Access will be controlled by Eskom personnel, who will remain on site during filming activities.
- 13. Eskom may request a finished copy of the final product if it deems it fit to do so.
- 14. All Covid-19 protocols to be adhered to i.e. wearing of masks at all times, social distancing, frequent sanitising and completion of a temperature check and Covid questionnaire prior to entering the power station.
